Orange Blossom August 2015 Intergroup Report

Hello fellow Al-Anons.

I have been focusing on tightening up the loose ends regarding the Orange Blossom and the requirements for submission, type of content and any other issues that may come up. As a result, I have come up with the following information. Please share this with your meetings.

1) All submissions to the Orange Blossom must include, either in the flyer or in the email, the groups identification number. We will be checking to make sure that all the content submitted are from listed meetings. The meeting rep can provide the number or you can contact Julia at the information office (714) 748-1113. The group number can also be found in the meeting directory, just before the meeting name. Please keep your meeting information updated so we don't have any issues with your submissions.

2) Submissions to the Orange Blossom are Al-Anon events, announcements and information. So, keeping with the idea of no outside affiliations, only Al-Anon events may be included in the Orange Blossom. These events may be approved AA events with Al-Anon participation but must read "with Al-Anon participation" on the flyers.

On page 56 of the Service Manual it states: "It is important that only Al-Anon/Alateen events are announced in our meetings. Because of our special relationship with A.A., A.A. events with Al-Anon and Alateen participation can be announced, but at an Al-Anon meeting or meeting location, groups do not announce or discuss activities of other Twelve Step programs. Publicizing events of other organizations creates an appearance of affiliation, even if the event is composed primarily of Al-Anon or Alateen members."

On page 124 of the Service Manual it states: "At an Al-Anon/Alateen meeting, in keeping with the Al-Anon/Alateen focus, the groups do not announce or discuss activities of other anonymous Twelve Step programs. Al-Anon/Alateen Area newsletters and local bulletins may publicize activities of Al-Anon/Alateen groups and those A.A. activities with Al-Anon participation. Publicizing other organizations' activities creates an appearance of affiliation."

3) All submissions to the Orange Blossom which include Alateen participation must be approved by the area Alateen rep. This includes all events and speaker meetings. Forms and more information regarding Alateen events can be found on the SCWS website: <http://www.scws-al-anon.org/> under the Alateen tab. More will be revealed in the future. Jayme C. and Cathleen C. will be putting together a more detailed email that will be passed on to all Intergroup Chairmen, Intergroup Editors and Intergroup paid employees with the pertinent information. Until then, please direct any Alateen questions about publication requirements to Cathlene C., The Alateen Sponsor Coordinator at alateen@scws-al-anon.org.

4) Please make sure when you are creating flyers and information for the Orange Blossom, to check your spelling. The correct spelling is: Al-Anon. I do try to catch spelling errors but they can slip by, especially my own. I do cut and paste information sometimes that is sent to create flyers or calendar events. It's progress not perfection! Thank you.

- 2015 budgets \$1.7 mil contributions
 - 12% increase over 2014
- 15,496 groups
- 9,461 = 61% contribute avg \$119 each
- *If* 15,496 avg \$119 each = \$1.84 mil contributions

2015 WSC: FINANCES p. 15

- Estimated Revenue 2015
 - \$1,700,000 Contributions
 - \$3,050,000 Lit sales (after cost subtracted)
 - \$250,000 Forum Subscriptions
 - \$65,000 Investment Dividends / Tsfr from Reserve Fund
- Total = \$5,065,000

2015 WSC: FINANCES p. 15

- Estimated Bottom Line
 - 2015 Budget: Projected Shortfall \$52,000
 - \$5,065,000 budgeted estimated revenue
 - \$5,117,000 budgeted operating expenses
 - = -\$52,000

That is **-\$52,000** not +\$52,000
This is 1% of \$5 million
Unbalanced budget

 - Projected Shortfall \$52,000
 - Using Reserve Fund – fully self-supporting? Trad 7
 - 15,496 groups, 9,461 = 61% contrib avg \$119 each
 - Additional \$5.50 from 9,461 groups = \$52,000
 - or, Additional \$20 from 9,461 groups = \$1.7 mil budgeted
 - If total Additional = \$25.50, get \$1.752 mil
 - If 100% contrib \$119, total of \$1.84 mil
